TOURNAMENT RULES

1. All entrants must present their Colorado 600 Bowling Club membership card and current USBC card at tournament check-in.

If you have lost or misplaced your membership card - **You will be Required to purchase a New card for a \$5.00 fee.

- 2. Entrants shall use their highest USBC sanctioned league book average, based on 21 games, at the end of the 2023-2024 season. If this is not available, entrants may use their highest 2024 summer league average based on 21 games. New entrants with at least nine games as of October 4, 2024 may use that average. Entrants who do not meet these average requirements must bowl scratch. **All entering averages must be verified and the entrant must sign the entry form**. Rule 319a (2), 319d and 319e will not apply. Failure to use correct averages will disqualify scores if submitted average is lower than correct average resulting in additional handicap. Prize winnings will be based on submitted average if higher than correct average.
- 3. Entry fee(s) must accompany submitted entries. Entrants must enter the Handicap Event to be eligible for the Optional Scratch event and Fun Doubles event. Each entrant may bowl only once. Substitutions will not be allowed. Entrants will be scheduled to bowl in the order the entries are received. Tardy bowlers will start in the frame in progress.
- 4. Entries close <u>September 8, 2024</u>. **NO REFUNDS AFTER ENTRIES HAVE CLOSED. All entrants must report at least 30 minutes prior to their squad time. Entrants will bowl four (4) games across eight (8) lanes, and will bowl their first squad choice unless notified otherwise.
- 5. Handicap will be based on 90% of 230. For the Handicap Event the entrant's score will be the total 4- game series plus handicap. For the Optional Scratch Event the entrant's score will be the total of the three (3) highest games bowled with no handicap. For the Optional Fun Doubles Event partners will be paired from the entrants on the same squad, with lowest average paired with highest average and the combined scores will be the first three games plus handicap.
- 6. Prize funds for all three events will be separate and all prize money will be returned 100% on a ratio of at least 1 in 7. Fees for the optional events must be paid to qualify for scratch prize money and awards or for the fun doubles prize money and awards.
- 7. For the 4-game Scratch side pot the entrant's score will be the total of the four (4) games bowled with no handicap. You will be using the scores you bowl during the 600 tournament. You must enter the 600 Club Handicap Tournament event.
- 8. <u>Dress Code:</u> Please, you MUST have a collared shirt (polo, butterfly collar, or mock/mandarin collar) or a "Branded" Bowling Jersey/Shirt will be accepted. Clean jeans, Capri's are okay. Skirts/Skorts/Shorts are okay, **But must be at least 3 inches below the individual bowlers longest fingertip. **NO mid-drifts, hats, spaghetti straps, leggings/yoga pants/exercise athletic pants, or holes in clothes. **This Dress Code will be Enforced.
- 9. All other rules will be governed by USBC and administered by the Colorado 600 Bowling Club Board of Directors.

You are all encouraged to make copies of this entry form. For anyone new wishing to participate in this tournament – we will need a membership card filled out along with the membership fee of 10.00, in addition to the entry form, and any other applicable tournament fees.
